Promoting healthy diets and increased physical activity has been recognized as key to preventing diet-related chronic diseases. A better understanding of the main determinants of food choices will enable us to develop targeted policies and interventions that promote healthier eating patterns. In-depth understanding of drivers of food choices is also essential for developing successful products and services by the private sector, including the food industry.
